## Yearbook Submission Guidelines

Thank you for presenting your work at the 2009 annual meeting of the South Atlantic Philosophy of Education Society. As you may know, all papers that are presented at the annual meeting are eligible to be published in the society's Yearbook. We'd love to have you submit your work for consideration. Here are some guidelines:

- Papers normally run about 2500-3500 words; longer entries may still be considered, but may be asked to be edited.
- Citations and references should conform to the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association*, 6th Edition. No footnotes or endnotes, please.
- Each submission must be accompanied by an abstract of approximately 150 words.
- Each submission must be accompanied by a title page which contains the author's contact information. Please remove any self-identifying text from the actual paper.
- Papers should be submitted in .rtf, .doc, or .docx format to the Yearbook editor, Nakia Pope at [popen@winthrop.edu](mailto:popen@winthrop.edu) by **December 1st, 2009**. They will then be distributed for blind review to Yearbook reviewers. You should be notified about the status of your submission by **February 1st, 2010**.<sup>1</sup>
